<u>Freedom to Marry As Taught by the Catholic Church:</u> The Church regards holy matrimony as one of the seven sacraments instituted by Christ our Lord. **Marriage Between Two Catholics**. For 2 Catholics to be validly married they must

- (1) be of legal age to marry. In Canada the age to marry is 18.
- (2) not to be previously married according to Church law.
- (3) Be mature enough to understand that marriage is permanent and indissoluble; that it is based on mutual love and respect and expressed in fidelity to each other; that it be open to having children if the couple are capable of conceiving children; is made in complete freedom without external pressure.
- (4) Be married before a bishop, priest or deacon in a Catholic Church.
