<p><u>Burial Plots, St. Lawrence Cemetery:</u> A new plot costs \$200.00 for either a casket or cremains. If cremains are buried in any existing grave, the cost is \$100.00. Please pay by cheque to <u>St. Lawrence Cemetery Fund</u>. Receipts will be issued.</p> <p><u>Burial Plots, St. Francis of Assisi Cemetery:</u> A new plot is \$200.00 for either a casket or cremains and \$100.00 if cremains are buried in an existing grave. Cheques can be made out to <u>St. Francis of Assisi Cemetery Fund</u>, and receipts will be issued.</p> <p><u>Burial policies</u> for all of our graveyards forbid any burials of ashes or remains without approval of the parish priest. A short burial service with blessing of the remains and of the grave is necessary, as well as provision of information about the deceased for our burial records.</p>
