Phase 3 of Covid – 19 Recovery Plan

1. Masks are no longer mandatory but **Highly Recommended**
2. Social distancing is no longer mandatory, but is **Highly Recommended**.
3. **Hand sanitizing** before and after Holy Communion will continue to be practiced by the **priest and Eucharistic Ministers**
4. Sharing the Chalice and shaking hands at the Sign of Peace will **not** take place.
5. People who wish to receive Holy Communion on the tongue should wait for everyone else to receive Communion first.
6. All other mandates, i.e. Proof of vaccination and capacity limits, are no longer in effect.
7. The holy water fonts at the Church entrance will remain empty
8. At Sunday Masses we will resume the procession of the gifts (bread, wine, and the collection) to the altar; collecting the offerings with collection baskets in the pews; the assistance of at least one Eucharistic minister at St. Paul and St. Lawrence churches at communion and more ministers when necessary.

All Souls Day (Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed) is Wednesday, November 2. We will remember all who were buried in our graveyards this past year at the 3 Masses next weekend. As the name of the departed is read by Fr. Allan, a family member or friend may come forward to light a candle.
